







International Award "Trieste - Right to Dialogue" 1st Edition

1. Genesis and Purpose of the Award

The International Award "Trieste-Right to Dialogue" is promoted by **Associazione Poesia e Solidarietà**, in collaboration with the **International Study and Documentation Centre for Youth Culture (iSDC)** as part of the annual **World Youth Forum "Right to Dialogue"**, which proposed its institution during the 10th Edition dedicated to the "Dialogic Condition".

The Award supports the purpose of the Forum which intends to affirm the "right to dialogue" as a fundamental right

- a) by introducing to the international public opinion high-profile personalities who have contributed and contribute to the affirmation of the culture of dialogue in any field of their work, research, artistic expression, social commitment;
- b) by rewarding a work (published or unpublished) by a young scholar whose focus is represented by the "dialogic" question in all its possible manifestations (from philosophical-linguistic, historical and historical-cultural aspects, to international dialogue, intercultural or interreligious dialogue, in generational or gender issues ...).

2. Participation Rules

Applications must be sent by e-mail to the Organization Office at the address <u>dialogoaward@gmail.com</u> in accordance with the following rules:

SECTION A)

Personalities from any country and citizenship (Italian, European and non-European), regardless of age or profession, can be candidates for the award.

Self-applications are not allowed.

Applications can be submitted strictly meeting this essential requirement: candidate's curriculum vitae must be consistent with the purposes of the award.

The application to nominate a personality for the award must contain the following elements:

- 1) Full indication of the candidate's personal and biographical data, any affiliations, website, address, other data useful to know candidate's personality.
- 2) The Candidate's Curriculum Vitae highlighting his/her qualifications that make him/her worthy of the award as particularly linked to the promotion of the culture of dialogue.
- 3) Curriculum Vitae of the person who submits the application.
- 4) Full and clear motivation by which the person who submits the application justifies his/her proposal.

Section b)

Young scholars up to 35 years old (Italian, European or non-European) can be candidates for the award. Self-applications are allowed.

The application must contain:

- 1) The applicant's personal data
- 2) The applicant's Curriculum Vitae highlighting the aspects considered consistent with the purpose of the award
- 3) A copy of the work that is proposed to obtain the award must be attached to the application. In case of published work, it can be sent by regular mail (the same day the application is sent by email, the postmark serving as a proof: in any case the work must not arrive after the deadline of the competition) or in Publisher's version PDF attached to the application sent by mail; in case of unpublished work, it can be sent in PDF format attached to the application sent by mail.

Applications must be received by the Organization Office by 20th August 2018.

3. Awards

Prize will be awarded by an evaluation committee made up of prominent experts in different scientific and artistic fields

The name of the winners will be announced during the World Youth Forum "Right to Dialogue" 11th Edition which will be held from 28th to 30th September 2018 in Trieste.

The awarded personality will be invited in Trieste in this occasion or on an agreed date in order to receive the award and to have a lecture, performance or exhibition.

The winning young scholar will be invited to Trieste for the occasion of the forum to present his/her work.

For young scholars' unpublished works the possibility of publication can be considered.
